

Statement of Burial on the Field

Although it is most unlikely that any YWAMer will pass away during his or her time of service on the field, existing laws make it necessary to consider the possibility prior to travelling abroad. Your outreach may involve travel in places where, in the event of death, internment must take place within 24 hours of decease. If death occurs, it may be extremely difficult to make arrangements for returning the body to the home country and thus, burial must take place on the field.

In situations where arrangements to return the body to the home country can be made, it is usually very expensive. Many countries require that a living person accompany the deceased. For that reason we would like you to consider the following:
